

4th Grade's Road Trip Across California



Driving Question: How can we as travel agents use our knowledge of California's unique landmarks and geographical features to create the ultimate road trip across California?

Content: This project will cover a variety of 4th grade standards: math standards as the students work on the financial management aspect of the trip, knowledge of California's geography, reading comprehension, persuasive writing and presentation skills.

Standards:

- 4.1 Students demonstrate an understanding of the physical and human geographic features that define places and regions in California.
- 4.2 Students describe the social, political, cultural, and economic life and interactions among people of California from the pre-Columbian societies to the Spanish mission and Mexican rancho periods.
- 4.3 Students explain the economic, social, and political life in California from the establishment of the Bear Flag Republic through the Mexican-American War, the Gold Rush, and the granting of statehood.
- 4.4 Students explain how California became an agricultural and industrial power, tracing the transformation of the California economy and its political and cultural development since the 1850s.
- 4.5 Students understand the structures, functions, and powers of the local, state, and federal governments as described in the U.S. Constitution.
