

4TH GRADE'S 22ND MISSION PROJECT

DRIVING QUESTION

How can we, as Keepers of the Mission, choose an ideal location and design the 22nd California mission that will accomplish the goals of the church?

CONTENT

This project will cover a variety of 4th grade standards: social studies standards as the students make sure their 22nd mission aligns with the foundation set in the first 21 missions (HSS 4.2), persuasive writing (W 4.1, 4.10) and speaking and listening skills (SL 4.1-4.5), and engineering design standards (3-5ETS 1.1-1.3) as the students work to build models of their missions.

MAJOR PRODUCTS

Each group will draw blueprints of their mission, write a multiparagraph proposal report, create a Google Slides presentation to present their proposal, and build a 3D model of the mission.

PUBLIC PRESENTATION

The groups will present their final products to the class and Archbishop Fonte, the historical figure that set the 'keepers of the mission' on this journey.
