

4th Grade's Tiny House & New Beginnings Community



Driving Question: How can we, as philanthropists, engineer a tiny house and create a community development to provide a new beginning for the homeless population?

Content: Students are going to establish a tiny home and community for the homeless. After researching the different causes and effects of homelessness, they will individually engineer a 3D model of a tiny home. Then in teams as “developers”, they will plan a community with services and/or resources to help the homeless population. Proposed communities will be presented to volunteers as investors. This PBL unit focuses on real-world problems, while incorporating 21st century skills and mathematical practices.

Standards:

Mathematics:

- CCSS.MATH.CONTENT.4.MD.A.3: Apply the area and perimeter formulas for rectangles in real world and mathematical problems.

 - d. Provide a concluding statement or section related to the opinion presented.

Major Products:

- **Individual:** A 3D model of a fully furnished Tiny Home.
- **Group:** A plan and map for a community to help the homeless population find new beginnings.

Making It Public: The groups will present their development proposals to the class and their potential “investors”.
