## A Narrative Written by Second Grade Authors

### PROJECT IDEA:

Students will become authors and illustrators of their own narrative story. The stories they create will have real life situations and teach readers how our choices effect our outcomes. After the authors finish the process of revision and editing, they will present their stories inside our Library for peers and fellow Kinetic Academy students to learn about choices.

### DRIVING QUESTION:

HOW CAN WE, AS STUDENT AUTHORS, EXPRESS OUR REAL-LIFE STORIES THROUGH NARRATIVES AND HELP PEERS MAKE GOOD CHOICES?

### CONTENT:
