



Student Dress Code Agreement

A consistent dress code builds community and helps students focus on learning.
These guidelines apply from the time students arrive on campus.

ALLOWABLE: EVERYDAY ATTIRE

TOPS & DRESSES

- Solid-color collared polo shirts, long or short sleeve, in the approved colors shown above.
- Solid-color polo dresses in the approved top colors.
- Solid-color pinafore or jumper dresses in approved top colors or khaki; wear with a collared polo underneath.

BOTTOMS

- Solid-color pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, or leggings in the approved bottom colors shown above.
- Denim must be free of rips, tears, rhinestones, and decorative embellishments.
- Pants, shorts, skirts, and skorts must be worn at the waist. Shorts and skirts must reach mid-thigh or longer.
- Skirts and dresses must be worn with leggings or bike shorts in approved dress-code colors.

SPECIAL SPIRIT DAYS

- **KA T-Shirt Days - Fridays & field trips (TK-8):** Kinetic Academy logo or Logo of the Year T-shirts are allowed. Otherwise, wear a collared polo. No regular T-shirts.
- **College & Trade School Spirit Day - Wednesdays, East Campus Middle School only:** A college, university, or trade school T-shirt or sweatshirt may replace the polo. Otherwise, wear a collared polo.

ALLOWABLE: MORE ITEMS

OUTERWEAR

- Solid-color sweatshirts, jackets, and outerwear in black, white, gray, or any shade of blue.
- Sweatshirts are outerwear and do not replace the required collared polo.

FOOTWEAR, ACCESSORIES & LOGOS

- Tennis shoes are required on Physical Education days. Sandals with back straps are permitted.
- Hats and beanies with school-appropriate words or images may be worn outside only.
- Kinetic Academy embroidered-logo apparel from Lands' End is encouraged but not required. Brand logos up to 2" x 2" are permitted.

PROHIBITED STUDENT ATTIRE

- Regular T-shirts, including shirts in Kinetic Academy colors.
- Hats, hoods, or beanies indoors; any non-school-appropriate logos or images.
- Flip-flops, Crocs, or wheeled ("Wheele") shoes.
- Logos larger than 2" x 2", pictures, or non-school-appropriate wording.
- Printed fabrics: plaid, stripes, polka dots, camouflage, etc.
- Excessively baggy pants; shorts or skirts shorter than mid-thigh.
- Spaghetti straps or crop tops on free-dress days.
- Artificial nails (TK-5).^{*} Body piercings other than ears.^{*} Tattoos.^{*}

^{*} Artificial nails are not permitted for TK-5 because they pose a safety risk and may interfere with pencil grip, handwriting, and learning tasks.

^{*} Tattoos and body piercings can be distracting or intimidating and are inappropriate for all students. Piercings on the face, arms, hands, feet, and/or tongue are not allowed. Students will be asked to cover or remove these items.

CONSEQUENCES FOR DRESS CODE VIOLATIONS

1st offense	Warning note sent home notifying parents that the student is out of dress code.
2nd offense	Parent called to bring a change of clothes; Back Up Clothes in the Office (East & West).
3rd offense	Parent called in for a meeting.
